What is the World Figure 8® Tour: It is a Figure 8 series that leads up to the 35th Annual World Figure 8® Championship held at the Indianapolis Speedrome® September 8-10, 2011.

The World Figure 8® Tour III Champion will receive a minimum of \$1,000. They will also get a 5-foot championship trophy as well as a guaranteed locked-in (non-transferable) starting spot for the 35th Annual World Figure 8® Championship on September 10, 2011. World Figure 8® Tour events may be added.

2011 World Figure 8® Tour \$500 BOUNCEBACK BONUS: If a driver can win a World Figure 8® Tour feature and comeback the very next night to win the Speedrome Late Model Figure 8 feature, they will receive a \$500 bonus on top of their earnings.

What tires will they run in the World Figure 8® Tour III: The series will continue the World Figure 8® tradition of a common tire. These 10" tires will be available at the Speedrome for \$75 each plus all taxes.

World Figure 8® Tour III event format: Each night will have qualifications, heat races (except July 2nd), and a 100-lap feature (Sportsdrome is a 50-lap feature). Each main event will pay \$1,200 to the winner (see the full purse below). Drivers will receive qualifying, heat, and feature points towards the championship.

FEATURE – 200, 195, 190, 185, 180, 175, 170, 165, 160, 155, 150, 145, 140, 135, 130, and 125 for anyone who starts the feature
